THE AMERICAN MATH OLYMPIAD (AMO) IS AN INTERNATIONAL MATH COMPETITION for elementary, middle and high school students, grades 2 through 11/12. Organized by the Singapore International Mastery Contest Center (SIMCC) and Southern Illinois University Carbondale (SIU), 2021 will be the first time the competition is conducted in the USA.

To promote a deeper understanding of math with a framework based on Common Core Standards, professional educators from SIU have designed a challenging curriculum to encourage interest in math through the American Math Olympiad (AMO) international math competition.

Awards and prizes include university scholarships, Global Scholars Program and International Junior Honor Society memberships, tuition grants and internships.

During the testing period, October 16 through November 14, take the test at your school or one of the special testing events on-campus at SIU. Select dates for SIU on-campus options are available for grades 6-12.

Students whose score is in the top 20% will be invited to attend the international competition in Singapore on January 8, 2022!
