November Speaker: Byron Hetzler

The Best Job in the World



Byron Hetzler will share some of the highlights of his nearly 40-year career as a photographer and some of his favorite images from his time in Southern Illinois.

Byron Hetzler has been the photographer at the Southern Illinoisan for nearly eight years. He came to Carbondale after 28 years of living and working in the mountains of Colorado. There, among other things, he was the photographer for the Winter Park ski area and was a freelance photographer for 10 years. He then returned to his journalism roots as the photographer for the Sky-Hi News in Granby, Colorado, where he received numerous Colorado Press Association awards for his news, sports and feature photos. He was born and raised in Iowa City, Iowa and received his bachelor's degree in journalism from the University of Iowa before taking Horace Greeley's advice to head west.

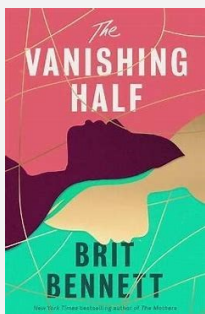
